Volunteer Registration

Location & dates

The World Expo of Beer will be held in Frankenmuth, MI at Harvey Kern Pavilion in Heritage Park on a Friday & Saturday in May. Please check website for specific dates & times.

Minimum Age Requirements

All volunteers must be a minimum of 21 years of age or older before the event to volunteer. Photo IDs will be checked upon arrival.

T-shirt/clothing

Your volunteer t-shirt is your uniform. You must wear it at all times when you are volunteering. You will receive an event t-shirt when you check in prior to the beginning of your shift. Your pants, skirt and the rest of your clothing must be appropriate for the event.

Those unable to adhere to this policy will be asked to leave the event & forfeit their volunteer perks.**
